Mail or bring to UGM your Family Contribution (1 per camper). Please refer to the chart below to determine how much money to contribute. On the left, find the category for how much income your household makes in one year. Match that line to the box that lines up with how many people are in your household (including yourself). E.g. If my household (both my partner and I) makes \$21,000 per year combined and we have 3 people in our household (including myself), I contribute \$20 for each camper. Please call us at 604-253-4044 if you need help figuring this out!

- We accept cash, money orders and certified cheques (made out to Union Gospel Mission), but **do not accept personal cheques!** *Note: UGM does not cover additional expenses such as upgrades, transportation costs not included in fees, or extras (t-shirts, DVDs, etc.).*
- If you are on **Income Assistance** or **Disability**, we require a **\$200 Summer Camp Subsidy** cheque made out to Union Gospel Mission. You can apply for this through your assistance office. Please indicate your assistance office location on your application for us to apply on your behalf.
- If you are a **foster parent**, we require a contribution of **\$125 per child** (based on current Foster Family Care Rates).
- If you are attending family camp, we require a contribution of **\$20 per camper**. Children 3 or under are free.
